

TREASURES OF EUROPE / 11 DAYS

Highlights:-

- **London:** Westminster Abbey, Big Ben, Tower of London, Buckingham Castle, Piccadilly, Circus, Trafalgar Square, Madame Tussuads, Swaminarayan Mandir
- **Belgium:** City tour of Brussels, Atomium (photo stop)
- **Netherland:** Amsterdam – Diamond factory, canal cruise, entry to Keukenhof Tulip gardens or Madurodam, Volendam - Cheese and Clog making factory
- **Germany:** Cologne Cathedral, Drubba Clock Factory, Black Forest & R. Rhine Boppard Cruise + Indian dinner
- **Switzerland:** Lucerne, Interlaken, Rhine Falls, Mt Titlis, Jungfrauoch, Geneva
- **France:** Disneyland® Park entrance or Chateau & Gardens of Versailles. City tour of Paris and River Seine boat cruise and Eiffel tower (3rd level).

Day 01: London Arrival

- Arrive and transfer to the hotel.
- Rest of the day at Leisure or take one of the optional tours
- Overnight at London, UK

Day 02: London

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed for **City Tour** of London which includes visit to the enchanting Swaminarayan Temple, one of the largest Italian marble temples outside of India. Later drive to the centre of London to see Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, The Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Tower of London and Buckingham Palace.
- Visit the **London Eye** which offers panoramic views of London. Later visit **Madame Tussauds**. Here take photos with all time celebrities such as Amitabh Bachchan, Mahatma Gandhi and various others
- Overnight at London, UK

Day 3: UK – Dover – Calais - Brussels – Holland (450kms from Calais)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- This morning arrive at your dedicated pick up point, where you receive a warm welcome from your Tour Director for your coach tour to Europe
- Later proceed onto Dover. On arrival admire the white cliffs before boarding ferry for the short channel crossing over to Calais.
- Once you arrive into the port, you continue your journey towards Brussels.

- Orientation tour of Brussels includes the Atomium structure (photo stop), a visit to the Grand Place, as well as a stop to see the Mannekin Pis.
 - Later continue your journey to Holland. Arrive Amsterdam and check in at the hotel
 - Overnight at Amsterdam, Holland

Day 4: Madurodam / Keukenhof – Volendam – Amsterdam (200kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
 - You drive towards The Hague, the political capital of The Netherlands; you start by visiting the Keukenhof flower gardens (between 22nd March to 20th May 2012). After this period you will visit the famous Madurodam model village.
 - Later, enjoy a demonstration on the art of making wooden shoes at the Clog Factory & Cheese Farm. You then proceed to the famous fishing village of **Volendam**.
 - Later proceed to Amsterdam to visit the renowned Diamond factory; continuing on you will discover the city in the most novel manner, as you take a canal cruise on the intricate waters which is best way to see this captivating city.
 - Overnight at Amsterdam, Holland

Day 5: Germany – Cologne – Koblenz - Boppard Rhine Cruise with Indian dinner (530kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
 - Drive to Cologne, famous for the Eau de Cologne you start by a visit to the magnificent Cologne Cathedral. This 515 ft tall Gothic Cathedral is Germany's most visited monument which took almost six centuries to build.
 - Later you proceed towards Koblenz where you will see the famous monument of "**Deutsches Eck**" where the two rivers meet the River Rhine and River Mosel. Enjoy an Indian dinner onboard a cruise whilst viewing the picturesque perched castles along the Rhine Valley, exclusive to the group only. (On occasions the dinner cruise may not operate, in this case you will still enjoy the cruise but will be taken to a restaurant for dinner)
 - Overnight at Germany

Day 6: Drubba – Black Forest – Rhine Falls - Switzerland (450kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Later you drive to Switzerland through the famous **Black Forest region** of Germany. You'll stop at the **Drubba Centre**, which is in the heart of the forest, where you have an opportunity to buy Cuckoo clocks & other souvenirs.
- Later you'll proceed to **Schaffhausen** to see the gigantic Rhine Falls, Europe's largest plain waterfalls. You have some free time to admire the thunderous beauty of the falls.
- Arrive Switzerland and check in at the hotel..

- Overnight at Switzerland

Day 7: Mt. Titlis – Lucerne (100kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Today's highlight of the tour is the visit to the highest viewpoint in central Switzerland. A wonder that is not to be missed, ascending the **Mt Titlis** to witness a spectacular view of glacier grotto (ice cave) and icefalls. This is viewed directly from the ROTAIR - the world's first revolving aerial cable car on Mt Titlis at 10,000 feet.-
- Later proceed for an orientation tour of Lucerne, one of the six most frequently visited cities in the World. See the Lion Monument, which is designed as a memorial for the mercenary soldiers.
- You may take a stroll across the **Kappelbrücke** - the world's oldest covered wooden bridge.
- Overnight at Switzerland

Day 8: Interlaken – Mt Jungfrauoch (360kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Today you start your day by visiting Interlaken- a picturesque town situated between two lakes. You start by taking an exciting excursion to **Mt. Jungfrauoch**, the highest altitude railway station in Europe at 11,133 ft. Marvel at the changes in alpine scenery as your charming cogwheel train takes you on a unique journey to Mt. Jungfrauoch.
- Experience the magic of the mountains at the Sphinx Terrace. Also, visit the Ice Palace, where you see a beautiful display of sculptures made of ice, while being encased in ice yourself.
- Do not forget to send a postcard to your friends and family from Europe's highest post office with its own special postmark.
- Overnight at Switzerland

Day 9: Geneva – Paris (600kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Geneva. Arrive and proceed for city orientation tour of Geneva which includes photo stops at the United Nations' building, the flower clock, the Reformation Monument and the famous Lake Geneva.

- Later you leave the Swiss Alps behind and head towards Paris. Upon arrival, enjoy a scenic boat cruise along the River Seine.
- You will be enchanted as you pass by many of the Parisian monuments including the Alexander II Bridge, the Orsay Museum, the National Assembly and Paris' own Statue of Liberty.
- Tonight enjoy an exciting optional Lido Show which has been a venue for the finest shows since 1946.
- Overnight at Paris, France

Day 10: Paris City Tour with Versailles Chateau & Gardens (100kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- You will travel to a small town outside Paris, Versailles the former residence of the famous "Sun King" where you visit the Chateau and the Gardens of Versailles, which count among the most prestigious of the world's heritage sites. It represents the most accomplished achievement of 17th century French Art.
- You will get the chance to visit the famous State Apartments of the King and Queen, and the Hall of Mirrors. Later you will drive down to central Paris, to see the Opera House, Concorde Square, Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe and other historical sites.
- You will also have some free time at the Louvre Museum (entrance not included) where you can see the famous [Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa](#) and other spectacular paintings and sculptures, or can just just indulge in some free time for shopping.

Day 11: Paris – Calais - Dover – UK (290kms to Calais)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- This morning, check out of the hotel and proceed to visit the top floor of the Eiffel Tower (Subject to availability).
- Later you embark on an orientation tour of Paris where you will drive through and see some of the most famous sights such as the **Champs-Elysees** street, the **Bastille building, ArcDe Triomphe, Louvre museum, Concorde Square** and many more historical monuments.
- In the early afternoon you depart for Calais for the ferry crossing to Dover.
- Upon arrival, you proceed towards your final destination.
- Your tour ends here and bid farewell to all friends you have made on the tour.
